1. Introduction

This Quarterly Progress Report is being submitted to the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) pursuant to the requirements of Paragraphs 1 and 2 of Section XIII of the AOC3 executed between the Parties and NDEP on February 15, 2006. The format of this report is based on the requirements stated in Paragraph 1 of Section XIII. This report covers activities between October 1 and December 31, 2013.

2. Actions Taken Towards Achieving Compliance

In addition to the various documents submitted to the NDEP discussed below, BRC and NDEP held meetings and telephone calls in order to achieve progress on project activities. Telephone meetings were held between the BRC management, the BRC Project Manager and the NDEP Project Manager (occasionally along with representatives from the City of Henderson as well as consultants representing the prospective property buyer) roughly every two weeks. Minutes of these meetings are maintained separately.

The CAMU (Phase V only) remains open in order to accept wastes as needed and will remain open till remediation activities cease and the requisite soils NFAs are obtained from the NDEP. Wastes from various "polygon" scrapes from the Eastside were placed into Phase V during this period. BRC also implemented various maintenance tasks at the CAMU, conducted repairs to rectify storm damage to portions of the CAMU storm channel during this period, and conducted leachate collection and sampling of the various CAMU sumps, as needed.

BRC submitted the data validation report for data collected as part of the field sampling for the first annual groundwater monitoring at the CAMU pursuant to the NDEP-approved long-term CAMU groundwater monitoring work plan.

During this period, BRC also re-submitted the application to the NDEP for renewal of the CAMU RAP. All NDEP comments that were received prior were addressed except for financial assurance. Discussions between NDEP and BRC on the documentation needed for post-closure financial assurance continued. As these discussions have progressed, BRC has also submitted to the NDEP certain design changes for the CAMU that are expected to be incorporated into the re-issued CAMU.

Additionally, BRC: (a) obtained the NFA for the Galleria ROW (i.e., including the two additional small pieces to the ROW's previous NFA); (b) resubmitted the HRA to the NDEP for the Sunset North sub-area addressing NDEP comments; (c) obtained the NFA for the North of Galleria ROW (NoROW) sub-area; (d) continued clean soils placement activities in the Hook/Open Space sub-areas; (e) continued cleanup activities (iterative confirmation sampling/scraping) in the Eastside Main sub-area; (f) continued scraping and consolidation activities of impacted soils in the Triangle area near Pabco

Rd/Warm Springs Rd/Jokers Wild casino for ultimate placement into the CAMU; and (g) continued discussions with the NDEP on various policy and technical groundwater issues including discussions on the Technical Memorandum relating to upgradient groundwater issues for the Eastside, with focus on arsenic as an example.

Results of previous confirmation sampling were received and analyzed and appropriate data validation activities also occurred.

3. Sampling Conducted

BRC collected various samples in support of the remediation effort including confirmation and re-confirmation soil samples as noted above in targeted portions of the Eastside Main and Triangle areas.

4. Work Plans and Other Deliverables Submitted Including Modifications

Attachment A shows a list of all documents that were submitted to NDEP in this period. Attachment B shows a list of all NDEP documents received during this period.

5. Actions Scheduled for Next Quarter

Activities planned include: completing placement of clean fill on portions of the Hook/Open Space sub-area; obtaining the NFA for the Sunset Industrial sub-area; likely submittal of the HRA for the Eastside main sub-area after concluding scraping and iterative confirmation sampling of the targeted polygons in the Eastside Main (exclusive of the Triangle area); completing the assessment of the Triangle area including sampling after debris/impacted soils removal; completing the HRA to support the NFA for the Hook sub-area and the Open Space sub area; resolving the financial assurance documentation issues associated with the RAP renewal leading to its reissuance; and continuing policy and technical discussions with the NDEP regarding various groundwater issues for the Eastside including providing feedback to the NDEP on its draft BMI groundwater policy document.

The following Work Plans and Other Deliverables are planned to be submitted to the NDEP in the next period:

- (i) Revised Project Schedule (updated as needed).
- (ii) Various Data Validation Summary Reports, as needed.
- (iii) Various documents discussed above.

Additional documents may also be submitted depending on project progress.

6. Completions, Delays and Mitigations

While the remediation effort is not on schedule, BRC and the NDEP continue to have discussions and to make progress in streamlining various project submittals and approvals.

7. Planned Modifications to Remedial Actions

None planned.
