   Loading out dried material from SW-4 using 345 excavator. (4) haul trucks hauling to beta ditch stockpile. 194 loads, (3,880) cy.
- Leveled material from SW-4 on staging area and beta ditch using D6 dozer...
- D8 Dozer disking wet pond material that is spread over the dry ponds.
- Versatile tractor and pans transporting dried out material from CTR-2 and spreading at stockpile. 41 loads, (1,230) cy. SW-8, 345 excavator remediating additional discolored soils below liner. Monitored by Construction Manager. (108) loads = (2,376) cy, to beta - ditch stockpile. Two spots excavated an additional 10' total, still discolored.
