Eastside Mixing and Drying Activity:

- Loaded out wet soils from SW-5 with CAT 345 excavator (4) trucks hauled 188 loads @ 20 cy/load = 3,760 cy. Spreading at dry ponds.
- Tractor and pans 69 loads @ 30 cy/loads = 2,070 cy prepared material 1 tractor.
- Watered haul Rds and Maintained them with 4,000 gal Water truck and Motorgrader.
- CAT 324 Long Stick excavator, No activity. Being repaired.
- Continued pumping water from SC-1 to SW-12.
- D6 Dozer and 2nd Water truck continued roughing in haul roads on dry ponds, east side.
- Completed trenching between the H-structure and the trailers for phone lines.

- Northwest Detention Basin excavation 631/637 scrapers (0) cy. 0 scraper. No activity.
- -Relocated exclusion zone fencing around the Phase 1 CAMU.
- Impacted soils over Phase 3A, continued power screening 1° minus soils. AAG Supt and 1 operator maintaining screener.
- Screened 1" minus clean soil from 200,000 yd stockpile and used it to place on the Northeast bench between phase 1 and phase IIIB. To cover the geomembrane.
